ARCHITECTURE PROJECT AND THE PROBLEMS

Karawaci, April 2, 2009 – Architecture project is part of the construction project in Indonesia. Architecture projects are identical with the building project, whether from low building category, medium and high, and the category of single-function to multiple functions, has a unique character and complex. The uniqueness and complexity of what happened other than the design model structure has also closely related to the interaction of the participants who consisted of: the project owner, consultant planners, contractors, suppliers, and others.

In the first activity held June 22, 2007, issue of Architecture Project characters are clearly revealed, and through experience in practice, the public began to recognize the problem.

In both these activities, issues Design, Ethics & Profession, and Context in Construction Management Architecture Project is expected to reveal a profound knowledge to enhance awareness in anticipating the various problems existing architectural projects in the future.

This case will be discussed from three aspects, namely: the design aspects, ethics and professionalism as well as construction management context. Through this seminar the participants will be expected to get:

1. Know, understand, and discuss various construction projects, specifically Architecture Project.
2. Know and understand the various problems that occurred in the Architecture Project, both associated with the parties and design.
3. The development process and building operational processes as part of the implementation process of the building.
4. Knowing and understanding the role of Construction Management in various construction projects, especially projects of Architecture.
